Program Results

S.A.F.E. House serves domestic violence victims, their children, their family members, batterers, and members of the community at large regardless of age, race, national origin, ancestry, religion, education, marital status, socioeconomic status, sexual preference and ability to pay for services. The statistics below reflect client served between July 1, 2012 - June 30, 2013.

- **COMMUNITY OUTREACH/TRAINING REACHED OVER 11,400 PEOPLE**
